The Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Water Quality Division (WQD) is enclosing the authorization to operate in compliance with General Permit No. OKLAS2100004, for a one-time application of biosolids from the Cement Public Works Authority (Authority) Wastewater Treatment Plant. The Authority's application for this authorization was submitted to DEQ on June 10, 2021. DEQ received additional information from the Authority regarding the characteristics of the biosolids on July 21, 2021. On August 12, 2021, DEQ issued the Authority General Permit No. OKLAS2100004 authorizing land application to the Coffey Site. On August 12, 2024, DEQ received a revised application and request to amend the permit with an additional site. The proposed site meets the criteria for the one-time land application of biosolids; therefore, DEQ is amending General Permit No. OKLAS2100004 to include the use of the Day Site.

This authorization is approved in accordance with requirements of Oklahoma Administrative Code 252:606, as adopted and promulgated pursuant to the Environmental Code, 27A Oklahoma Statute.

The authorization is for a one-time application of biosolids to the following sites:

APPROVED:

- Coffey Site: 160 acres located within the NE¼ of Section 18, Township 6 North, Range 8 West of the Indian Meridian, Grady County, Oklahoma.
- Day Site: 79 acres located within the E½, SW¼, of Section 33, Township 6 North, Range 9 W of the Indian Meridian, Caddo County, Oklahoma

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The sludge operation authorized by this permit should be maintained in accordance with the plan approved by DEQ. DEQ must approve any deviation from the approved plan in writing before changes can be made. I am returning a copy of the signed Permit for your records.
