The Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Water Quality Division (WQD) issued authorization, No. OKLAS2200005, on May 20, 2022, to operate in compliance with General Permit OK65S, for a one-time application of biosolids from the City of Lawton's (City) Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF). Additional information submitted to DEQ, via email, on June 29, 2022, stated that at the request of the landowners, the City is no longer planning to utilize the following land application sites:

Site 1: 160 acres in the NW¼ of Section 28, Township 1 North, Range 11 West of the Indian Meridian, Comanche County, Oklahoma;

Site 3: 47 and 64 acres in the NE¼ of Section 32, Township 1 North, Range 11 West of the Indian Meridian, Comanche County, Oklahoma;

Site 6: 160 acres in the NE¼ of Section 33, Township 1 North, Range 11 West of the Indian Meridian, Comanche County, Oklahoma;

Site 7: 160 acres in the NW¼ of Section 34, Township 1 North, Range 11 West of the Indian Meridian, Comanche County, Oklahoma;

The sites are removed from the City's General Permit No. OKLAS2200005 and this document should be made a part of the permanent record. Any change or deviation from the Permit must be approved in writing by DEQ. If you have any questions, feel free to contact me at (405) 702-8108 or write to me at the letterhead address.
